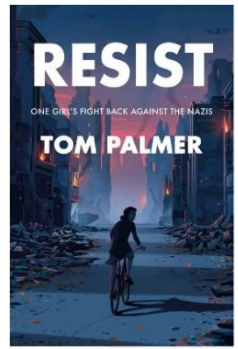


RESIST by Tom Palmer



Velp is the main location in “Resist”, a real town in the Netherlands (also known as Holland), where a young girl called Edda braved the Nazi occupation during the Second World War.

Edda grew up to be the famous film star and humanitarian, Audrey Hepburn.

Using this map, try to locate some of the key settings in the book and colour them in as suggested.

1 In the opening scene, Edda crosses the railway line to Arnhem on her bicycle to deliver resistance newsletters.
Colour the railway line RED

2 Edda volunteers her time washing bandages. Colour this important healthcare public building BLUE?

3 Hidden in trees to the North of Velp, Edda finds a US airman who has been shot down and helps him escape from the Nazis.
Colour these woods GREEN

4 In a house in the North West of Velp, Edda acts as the lookout whilst her grandad and his friend listen to the secret radio station, Radio Oranje.
Colour this house ORANGE

5 Edda performs at an illegal evening dance show in the southern part of Velp, to help raise money for the resistance.
Colour this house PINK

6 Edda and her family hide in their cellar when all-out war breaks out on their streets.
Colour their house in PURPLE
