

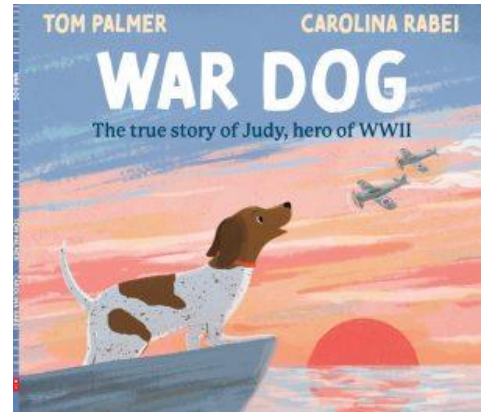
War Dog by Tom Palmer

to those who are looking out for you?**

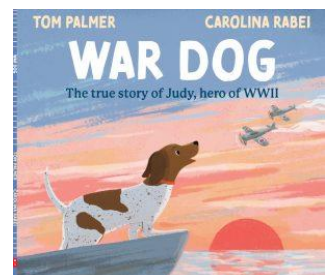
The crew stand up for Judy when she is threatened.
